- 1 **Remember to SAVE TO YOUR FILE LOCKER!**
- 2 Right-align and single-space the **seven-line heading** - - like the one above
- 3 Double space the **five paragraphs** of your paper. Hint: Go to the menu bar to Format > Paragraph >Line Space>Double Space.
- 4 Edit your rough draft on the computer. Do a spell check too. Print out your rough draft.
- 5 Have another person edit your rough draft and write "Edited by _____" on the first page of the rough draft.
- 6 Make corrections on the computer according to the edited draft (those items with which you agree).
- 7 Go to Tools in the Menu Bar >Word Count. **Type** the word count on the final copy as shown in the heading above.
- 8 Print out and proofread your final copy. Staple final copy on top of rough draft.
- 9 Show paper to instructor and then place your assignment in your folder in the 2nd drawer of the tan file cabinet.

Scenario: Now that you have had the opportunity to experiment with video production and film making and have learned that it takes time and planning to produce a real production, you are a professional.

Explain how you worked on your promo video project. Justify why you selected the items you chose to include. Give examples of how you went through the design procedure to obtain your final result. Compare other video productions to the one you and your partner did. Tell why and how you came to your conclusions. Explain what special effects you chose and why they suited your production. (Remember that this is a PERSUASIVE writing of why you chose to complete your project in the manner you did).

1st Paragraph: Write an introduction by explaining the above scenario in your own words.

2nd Paragraph: Explain the design procedure you went through to obtain the final result of your promotional video. Justify why you selected the items you chose to include.

3rd Paragraph: Tell what special effects you chose and argue why your special effects best suited the interviews and scripts.

4th paragraph: Go out to the Internet and research words pertaining to your critical writing; include what you have found (IN YOUR OWN WORDS).

5th Paragraph: Write a closing summary comparing your video to similar videos you have seen in your life; explain why you feel your production is the best.
